#### **Updates**

Discussion was held around the improvements that have been made in dentistry services.

Dates for focus groups for Adult Learning have gone out wildly

There was some confusion about a meeting that was due to be held at Yorkshire Coast College. The meeting will look at discussing the development of the destination course provided by the college in order to bring back the provision for teaching students with complex needs for September this year. Students and parents were left without planned provision when the course ended last year and were not given the reasoning behind this.

David informed the group that the funding process to specialist colleges is changing. David to keep us informed.

Jane's job is 22½ hours to cover Scarborough, Whitby and Ryedale. The learning council looking at models of learning that are transferable. A discussion was held around some of the reasons why people are not taking places for Adult Learning Courses. This is why focus groups are being set up so that more information about what people want from Adult Learning courses. Jane was able to make more links for her campaign from today's meeting.

The North Yorkshire Wider Transition Steering Group meeting is scheduled for next week. There are 3 sub groups which look at different aspects of transition including looking at transition information.
